Exitus <i>Bourbon Barrel Aged</i>, California 2016 (<i>Zinfandel, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Sauvignon</i>)	10	30
<i>86 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> A touch of Bourbon-like sweetness softens this full-bodied wine that is very fruity, smooth and easy to sip. It doesn't go to the smoky extremes of others in this category, and has an eye-catching bottle design that evokes an old-fashioned whiskey bottle.

BV Coastal Estates, California 2017	10	30
Classic in style, showing intense varietal character over a soft, supple profile. Fresh cherries and summer plums open the aromas. On the palate, the fruit gains complexity and depth, adding subtle layers of leather and forest floor. French oak stitches the bright fruit together, leaving just a hint vanilla.

<i>86 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> Vivid fruit with balanced tannins with a supple, velvety texture. It starts with vibrant color and offers aromas of cherries and fresh raspberries. The flavors are a focused combination of black plum and blueberry with subtle notes of cedar.

<i>91 points Wine Spectator.</i> This is lovely, tempting the nose with violet-tinged currant and blackberry fruit, washing easily over the tongue with a graceful balance of fruit and spice, lingering effectively as the flavors hover.		
Maggy Hawk <i>Stormin'</i>, Alexander Valley, California 2014	N/A	50
<i>92 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> This full-bodied and relatively pale-colored wine offers a pretty combination of light cherry, cinnamon and nutmeg flavors. A sweet-seeming ripeness adds to the luxurious texture. Firm acidity and a backdrop of fine-grained tannins balance it out and counter the richness beautifully.

<i>90 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> Aromas of scorched earth, black cooking spice and ripe berry lead the nose. The medium-bodied, easy-drinking palate doles out fleshy black cherry, ripe raspberry, licorice and ground pepper alongside polished tannins.

Waterbrook, Columbia Valley, Washington 2015	12	36
<i>86 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> Aromas of vanilla, cocoa and woodspice are at the fore. The palate starts out broadly but then trails as it moves toward the finish		
Steele, Lake County, North Coast, CA 2012	10	30
A lush, generous wine that brims with dark fruit flavor. Aromas and flavors of plum and boysenberry mingle with soft notes of licorice and mocha. This wine is full-bodied, the tannins are rich, and the finish lingers with a persistent spice.

<i>91 points James Suckling.</i> A fresh and clean red with berry, hazelnut and stone character. Medium-to-full body, firm and silky tannins. Bright.

J Lohr <i>Seven Oaks</i>, Paso Robles, Central Coast, CA 2016	N/A	21
<i>90 points Wine Enthusiast "Editor's Choice".</i> Black cherry, smoke and a hint of caramel make for a very familiar and satisfying nose. There is a deep core of black currant fruit, with chalky tannins, a dense mouthfeel and abundant acidity that drives into the finish.		
Josh <i>Craftsman's Collection</i> by Joseph Carr, California 2015	12	35
The bouquet bursts with intense dark fruits, cinnamon, clove and subtle oak aromas. The palate is dominated by flavors of black cherries and juicy blackberries, accented by delicate vanilla flavors and toasty oak finishing long with round, soft tannins.		
Rodney Strong, Sonoma, California 2015	15	44
<i>88 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> Smoky oak and chewy tannin provide a stiff backbone to this rich dark-fruited wine, made to be enjoyed in its youth. Tobacco, black pepper and turned earth add complexity to a rounded midpalate of lush black cherry and plum.		
Rutherford Ranch Reserve, Napa Valley, California 2012	18	51
<i>92 points Decanter.</i> Glossy black cherry aroma with nicely judged oak and lovely concentration. The palate is softer than the nose suggests, yet there are robust tannins supporting the ripe fruit. Good acidity gives line and persistence. Unusually moreish.		
Educated Guess, Napa Valley, California 2016	19	54
<i>90 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> This wine shows good concentration in color, flavor and texture. It is deep and dark, with ripe, jammy tones of blackberry and black cherry. Significant baking-spice elements add complexity, while fine-grained tannins add a thick texture.		
Broadside <i>Ephemeria</i>, Paso Robles, Central Coast, CA 2014	N/A	70
<i>94 points Wine Enthusiast.</i> This expertly woven wine proves very cohesive and well balanced. Blueberry and blackberry aromas meet with charred wood, Graphite and chocolate on the elegant nose. The ripe berry flavors are wrapped in cocoa and light cedar spice, laced together with buoyant acidity

Predator, Lodi, California 2015	11	32
Smoky, charred aromas and roasted flavors give this full-bodied wine a big, rowdy personality, nearly outshining the fruit flavors. That heavy toast an oak-derived attribute that tends to polarize wine drinkers, but those who love it will appreciate this wine.		
Rombauer, California 2016	20	60
<i>90 points Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.</i> Medium garnet-purple colored, it gives up preserved plums, raspberry pie and Black Forest cake with baking spices, underbrush and potpourri in the background. The palate is full-bodied, plush and juicy with loads of earth and spice layers on the finish.
