88 points Wine Enthusiast. Freshly squeezed Oro Blanco grapefruit juice shows on the nose of this bottling, along with touches of tangerine and lemon-lime soda. The grapefruit character extends to the clean, bright and pithy palate, making for a very refreshing experience.

88 point Wilfred Wong (Wine.com). Brilliant silver straw yellow in color. Intense aromas of apple blossom, ripe pear, and sweet lemon drop are complemented by toasty oak, spice, and cream. In the mouth, the silky texture of the wine is overlaid with bright, juicy flavors of ripe apple and pear for a long and fresh finish.

Scheid Family <i>District 7</i> , Monterey, California 2015	12	36
87 points Wine Enthusiast. Fresh lemon and lime zest aromas are sharp in the nose of this bottling, cutting into the oak smoke character. The mouthfeel is round and creamy, with more oak as well as melted butter, apple and lemon flavors.		

Decoy by Duckhorn, Sonoma, California 2016	13	39
87 points Wine Enthusiast. This wine pulls from across the wider appellation to combine cool-climate grapes with warmer regions. Round and easygoing, it offers fleshy fine flavors of pineapple and peach, its oak integrated and unobtrusive.		

Harken <i>Barrel Fermented</i> , Central Coast, California 2017	11	32
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86 points Wine Enthusiast. Vivid toasted-oak aromas and flavors dominate this full-bodied mouth-filling wine. Along with a charred-wood aroma come buttery butterscotchy flavors from a complete malolactic fermentation and a pear nectar component that provides the fruity side.

Kendall-Jackson Jackson Estate <i>Camelot Highlands</i> , Santa Maria Valley, CA 2012	N/A	40
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91 points Wine Enthusiast “Cellar Selection”. Lemon butter, apple pie crust and hazelnut are first to the aroma party on this carefully crafted Jackson family offering from a vineyard about 400 feet up in limestone-dotted soils. On the palate, strong but integrated acidity carries the myriad citrus, apple and spice flavors to completion.

Chanin Sanford & Benedict Vineyard, Sta. Rita Hills, CA 2014	N/A	60
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94 points Wine Enthusiast “Cellar Selection”. Extremely delicate on the nose, this wine from the historic vineyard shows bruised yellow grapefruit, sliced nectarine and crushed chalk aromas. The evolving palate starts daintily with cut apple and nectarine, then warms into seared peach, buttered popcorn and ripe pear flavors. A chalky, seashell-like structure and pithy texture ensure a long, interesting life. Drink 2018 through 2034.

Riesling*

Pale straw in color, offering aromas of paperwhites, daffodil, lemongrass, pear, ripe apple, and lychee. These delicious aromas are complemented on the palate by cool climate minerality rich texture, and a spritz of natural carbonation on the finish.

Leonard Kreuzsch Piesporter, Mosel, Germany 2016	8	24
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89 points Wine Enthusiast “Best Buy”. Spine tingling acidity marks this approachably forward, fruity Riesling. Medium sweet in style it offers ample white grapefruit and tangerine flavors off set by hints of earth, lime zest and herb.

Sauvignon Blanc*

87 points Wine Spectator. Vibrant aromatics of citrus, lychee, sweet herbs and a crisp minerality tease the refined acidity and refreshing finish.

Slingshot, Napa Valley, California 2016	11	33
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Refreshing and crisp with aromas of pineapple, mango, and white peach. With balanced acidity and a textured pallet, this wine features flavors of lemon zest, lime, and honey suckle.

Decoy by Duckhorn, Sonoma, California 2017	12	36
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89 points Wilfred Wong (Wine.com). This bright and aromatic wine offers enticing layers of lemon and lime zest, as well as lovely notes of honeydew and nectarine. On the palate, refreshing acidity mingles with a subtle undercurrent of sweet fruit that carries through to a refreshing, vibrant finish.

Michel Redde <i>La Moynerie</i> Pouilly-Fume, Loire Valley, France 2009	N/A	39
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92 points Wine Spectator. This is ripe, with peach and melon notes, but racy, with underlying citrus oil and salted butter flavors. Long, rich and creamy, but with ample definition through the finish, where a lovely smoke hint lingers.
