<b>Gérard Bertrand Heritage 'An 825' Brut</b> , Crémant de Limoux, Languedoc, France 2019 90 points <b>Wilfred Wong of Wine.com</b> . The 2019 Gérard Bertrand Héritage Crémant de Limoux Brut is pleasing and true-to-type. This wine deftly combines aromas and flavors of dried earth, sandalwood, and ripe fruit.		38
<b>Berlucchi '61 Rosé</b> , Franciacorta, Lombardy, Italy N/V 92 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Bright and savory, this refreshing, polished sparkler boasts alluring aromas of juicy raspberry, wild cherry, baking spice and a whiff of bread crust. The inviting aromas follow over to the vibrant palate along with a continuous refined perlage. A tangy candied nectarine note closes the finish.		38
<b>Veuve Clicquot, Brut, Yellow Label</b> , Champagne, France N/V 90 points - <b>Wine Spectator</b> . This is tightly knit and racy, with a spicy underpinning and a clean-cut mix of poached pear, grated ginger and pink grapefruit zest. An aperitif style, showing a crisp, lacy finish.		120

<b>Cavit</b> , Trevenezie, Italy 2020 <b>Winemaker's Notes</b> - Intense aromas with varied notes and candied citrus, ripe fruit and white flowers. Wonderfully refreshing sweetness with pleasant, delicious notes of apricot, white peach, sage and persistent aftertaste.	9	27

<b>Cavit</b> , Delle Venezie, Italy D.O.C. 2018 86 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This tangy white offers aromas and flavors of green apple, citrus and honeydew. It's simple but well-made.	N/A	12	N/A
<b>Lange Classiqué</b> , Willamette Valley, OR 2019 90 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> "Editors' Choice." So young and fresh it's still got a bit of light fizz (CO2) going on, this is a bracing wine, with lemon verbena, green apple, lemon oil and a palate-cleansing minerality. Made for early drinking, it's best with a light chill.	11		32
<b>Chloe</b> , Valdadige, Italy D.O.C. 2020 89 points - <b>Tastings</b> . Alluring aromatics lead into an intense expression of the Pinot Grigio grape with a generously structured mouthfeel. On the palate, fruit-forward flavors of juicy white peach, soft melon, crisp apple and floral honeysuckle lead to a crisp, refreshing finish with a subtle undertone of Meyer lemon.	11		30

<b>Harken</b> , Central Coast, CA 2020 86 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This wine is lush, very ripe and a bit heavy, oozing butter and apple-cider aromas followed by indulgent fruit flavors and a soft, syrupy texture.	10	30
<b>Robert Mondavi Reserve</b> , Carneros, CA 2016 92 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Steel acidity lifts the oak and fleshy body of this reserve-worthy wine—the core of flavor built around lush, decadent flavors of honey graham cracker, baked apple and lemon meringue. The richness is rewarding and softly beguiling on the palate.	12	36
<b>Clos Du Val Estate</b> , Carneros, Napa Valley, CA 2015 94 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . New management, farming and winemaking practices at this producer, including a focus on smaller production, are remarkably on display in this delicious white. Golden pear and crunchy apple provide an unctuous, delightfully balanced experience that's crisp in underlying acidity and subtle baking spice.	N/A	45
<b>Chanin - Sanford &amp; Benedict Vineyard</b> , Sta. Rita Hills, Santa Barbara, CA 2014 94 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> "Cellar Selection". Extremely delicate on the nose, this wine from the historic vineyard shows bruised yellow grapefruit, sliced nectarine and crushed chalk aromas. The evolving palate starts daintily with cut apple and nectarine, then warms into seared peach, buttered popcorn and ripe pear flavors. A chalky, seashell-like structure and pithy texture ensure a long, interesting life. Drink 2018 through 2034.	N/A	60

<b>Nobilo</b> , Marlborough, New Zealand 2020 <b>Wine Maker's Notes</b> - Fresh, crisp and clean with zesty flavors of ripe tropical fruits, especially passionfruit and pineapple with subtle hints of green herbs. The wine is intensely flavored with balanced mouthwatering acidity and a generous finish.	10	30
<b>Firestone</b> , Santa Barbara County, Central Coast, CA 2021 89 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Aromas of lime-peel, spring-flower buds, green peppercorn and herbs meet with wet cement on the nose of this zesty bottling. Lime-zest, sansho-pepper and more rainy sidewalk flavors come together on the focused palate.	13	35

Michelle's Columbia Valley Riesling but still shows the classic Chateau Ste. Michelle Riesling character. It offers rich flavors of ripe peaches balanced with crisp Washington Riesling acidity.	9	24
<b>Weingüter Wegeler Sonnenuhr- Spätlese</b> , Mosel, Germany VDP.GROSSE LAGE® 2015 90+Points- <b>Robert Parker's Wine Advocate</b> . Made with a bit of botrytis, the 2015 Wehlen Sonnenuhr Riesling Spätlese opens with an intense and piquant fruit aroma of lime and grapefruit flavors along with some herbal/grassy and nutty aromas. Light but very lush and fruity, with racy, crystalline acidity and a firm phenolic grip with a nicely salty finish	N/A	36
