#### Red Blend\*

<b>Palazzo “Right Bank” Proprietary Red</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2010 ( <i>Bordeaux-Style Blend</i> ) 96+ Points - <b>Robert Parker's Wine Advocate</b> . The 2010 is another wine of great intensity but coiled, very tight, with high levels of tannin. Sensational in extraction and richness, this blend of 72% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and the rest Cabernet Sauvignon is the product of a cool year in Napa. It shows fabulous density, richness, and intensity. It will evolve somewhat like the brilliant 2005 has, but it is still excruciatingly young, intense, promising, but needs to be forgotten for at least another 4-5 years and drunk over the following two decades. #### Pinot Noir\*

<b>Rickshaw</b> , California 2021 90 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This Pinot Noir shows integration of a variety of flavors and aromas that create a unique expression. Find notes of red cherry, cranberry, black tea, fresh and dried roses, basil, tarragon, toasted wood, and a desert-dust earthiness. The finish is pleasantly warm.	10	30
<b>A to Z</b> , Oregon, 2021 90 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This Oregon Pinot avoids the sort of winemaking tricks that take away detail and specificity. It is broadly flavorful with brambly blackberry and black cherry fruit, along with a streak of licorice.	16	45
<b>Williams Selyem</b> , Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA 2018 95 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Lush and earthy in all the right ways, this appellation wine is effusive and floral in a lovely bouquet of wild rose. Bright red fruit persists through the structured and well-integrated body, with fresh acidity and accents of black tea and cardamom lifting it up.	N/A	70
<b>Ken Wright Cellars – Tanager Vineyard</b> , Yamhill-Carlton, Willamette Valley, OR 2016 91 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This is a juicy mix of cranberry, pomegranate and raspberry fruit, with highlights of lightly peppery Mediterranean herbs. It smooths out into a broad midpalate and should be in a prime drinking window for another half decade.	N/A	55
<b>Belle Glos <i>Balade</i></b> , Sta. Rita Hills, Central Coast, CA 2020 93 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This lush, luxurious Pinot Noir begins with hearty aromas of baked black cherry, clove, nutmeg and smoke on the nose. There is undeniable power on the palate yet also some finesse, presenting flavors of black cherry laced with mace as layered tannins and acidity carry through the finish.	N/A	65

<b>Castello di Querceto</b> , Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy D.O.C.G. 2019 93 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . The brightness and clarity here is impressive, with aromas of black cherries and fresh flowers that follow through to a medium to full body, firm and linear tannins and a fresh, vivid finish.	16	42

#### Merlot\*

<b>High Heaven Vintners <i>Sea of Tranquility</i></b> , Columbia Valley, WA 2018 88 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Aromas of smoke, blueberry, raspberry and cherry are followed by blue and red fruit, vanilla and Creamsicle flavors that show a touch of bitterness on the finish. Firm, slightly dry tannins back it up.	10	30
<b>Trefethen</b> , Oak Knoll District, Napa Valley, CA 2017 90 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Deeply evocative of red fruit, dried herb and cedar, this soft supple wine offers an elegant style of complex structure and approachable texture and weight. Balanced and impressively quiet, it finishes in a woody note of oak.	N/A	55

<b>San Simeon <i>Estate Reserve</i></b> , Paso Robles, Central Coast, CA 2018 93 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Enhanced with a 20% addition of Petit Verdot, this bottling begins with aromas of black cherry, clove and cola-scented spice cake. Soft, polished tannins uphold the piquant red fruits on the sip, where peppery spices, charred meats and wild herbs add nuance.	N/A	38	N/A
<b>Rickshaw</b> , California 2020 88 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Quite fruity and not very tannic, this wine tastes fresh and easy, offering blackberries and blueberries and light oak spices. It is relatively light-bodied and will be great for casual occasions, even slightly chilled.	10		30
<b>Ely <i>Reserve by Callaway Cellars</i></b> , Napa Valley, CA 2017 88 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This is a waxy, fruity and lush red that is full bodied and ample in concentration and tannin. With 86% varietal imprint, it incorporates a juicy mix of 6% Zinfandel, 3% Syrah and smaller amounts of Petite Sirah and mixed reds, delivering soft simple flavor and structure.	12		36
<b>Penley Estate <i>Phoenix</i></b> , Coonawarra, Australia 2019 94 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This excellent wine offers aromas of blueberry, currant, terra cotta, iodine, savory spices and an umami-like seaweed nuance. There's lovely depth of flavor, tannin structure and regional expression on the palate.	14		48
<b>Kerr Cellars</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2018 93 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . A succulent, juicy young red with plum, dark berry and some tile and bark undertones. It's full-bodied with layers of pure fruit and fine tannins. Lightly chewy at the end of the palate with a savory and fruity finish.	22		60
<b>Sbragia – Godspeed Vineyard</b> , Mt. Veeder, Napa Valley, CA 2014 93 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . Aromas of blackberry, mint and spice. Hints of flowers. Medium to full body, firm and silky tannins and a fresh finish. Fine tannin tension. Linear and tight. I like the chocolate undertone at the close.	N/A		70
<b>Penfolds <i>Bin 704</i></b> , Napa Valley, CA 2018 96 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This is the first vintage of the Australian producer's foray into Napa Valley. It is tightly structured yet supple, bursting in bright currant and strawberry flavors. Savory components of sage, dried herb and black pepper dot the palate alongside silky tannins and chocolate-laced richness. A fresh touch of blood orange arises on the finish.	N/A		90

<b>Seghesio <i>Angela's Table</i></b> , Sonoma, CA 2021 92 points – <b>Wine Spectator</b> . Plush in texture, this Zin is generous with blackberry and cherry flavors that draw in accents of briar patch, black pepper and toasty cinnamon as it finishes with zesty tannins.	18	48
<b>Folie à Deux</b> , Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma, CA 2018 92 points – <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> “ <b>Editors’ Choice</b> ”. This big but sleek wine boasts full-bore black-cherry and black-currant flavors on a full body backed by moderate tannins. Yet it is nicely layered and smooth in texture and judiciously spicy in flavor, adding hints of clove and cedar to the powerful fruit.	18	48
