<b>Palazzo "Right Bank" Proprietary Red</b> ( <i>Bordeaux-Style Blend</i> ), Napa Valley, CA 2010 96+ Points - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate. The 2010 is another wine of great intensity but coiled, very tight, with high levels of tannin. Sensational in extraction and richness, this blend of 72% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and the rest Cabernet Sauvignon is the product of a cool year in Napa. It shows fabulous density, richness, and intensity. It will evolve somewhat like the brilliant 2005 has, but it is still excruciatingly young, intense, promising, but needs to be forgotten for at least another 4-5 years and drunk over the following two decades. <b>Robert Mondavi Red</b> ( <i>Bordeaux-Style Blend</i> ), Napa Valley, CA 2019 93 points - James Suckling. Bright and fresh with crushed red and dark berries, spices, and crushed stones. Medium- to full-bodied with chalky tannins. Velvety and textural with succulent wild berry notes underneath. Vivid finish. 74% Cabernet Sauvignon plus Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot.	24	60

<b>Rickshaw</b> , California 2021 90 points - Wine Enthusiast. This Pinot Noir shows integration of a variety of flavors and aromas that create a unique expression. Find notes of red cherry, cranberry, black tea, fresh and dried roses, basil, tarragon, toasted wood, and a desert-dust earthiness. The finish is pleasantly warm.	10	30
<b>A to Z</b> , Oregon, 2021 90 points - Wine Enthusiast. This Oregon Pinot avoids the sort of winemaking tricks that take away detail and specificity. It is broadly flavorful with brambly blackberry and black cherry fruit, along with a streak of licorice.	16	45
<b>Williams Selyem</b> , Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA 2018 95 points - Wine Enthusiast. Lush and earthy in all the right ways, this appellation wine is effusive and floral in a lovely bouquet of wild rose. Bright red fruit persists through the structured and well-integrated body, with fresh acidity and accents of black tea and cardamom lifting it up.	N/A	70
<b>Ken Wright Cellars - Tanager Vineyard</b> , Yamhill-Carlton, Willamette Valley, OR 2016 91 points - Wine Enthusiast. This is a juicy mix of cranberry, pomegranate and raspberry fruit, with highlights of lightly peppery Mediterranean herbs. It smooths out into a broad midpalate and should be in a prime drinking window for another half decade.	N/A	55
<b>Belle Glos Balade</b> , Sta. Rita Hills, Central Coast, CA 2020 93 points - Wine Enthusiast. This lush, luxurious Pinot Noir begins with hearty aromas of baked black cherry, clove, nutmeg and smoke on the nose. There is undeniable power on the palate yet also some finesse, presenting flavors of black cherry laced with mace as layered tannins and acidity carry through the finish.	N/A	70

<b>Cecchi Storia di Famiglia</b> , Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy 2020 D.O.C.G. 93 points - James Suckling. Rose hips, potpourri, cherries and brambleberries on the nose. Juicy and fruity with a medium body and fine tannins. Crunchy and bright. Wonderful drinkability.	17	50

<b>Columbia Crest H3</b> , Columbia Valley, WA 2018 91 points - James Suckling. Aromas of fresh red fruit and berries, thyme and cardamom. Full-bodied with fine tannins. Blackberry and baking spice wash across the palate. Rich, balanced and approachable.	10	30
<b>Trefethen</b> , Oak Knoll District, Napa Valley, CA 2017 90 points - Wine Enthusiast. Deeply evocative of red fruit, dried herb and cedar, this soft supple wine offers an elegant style of complex structure and approachable texture and weight. Balanced and impressively quiet, it finishes in a woody note of oak.	N/A	55

<b>San Simeon Estate Reserve</b> , Paso Robles, Central Coast, CA 2018 93 points - Wine Enthusiast. Enhanced with a 20% addition of Petit Verdot, this bottling begins with aromas of black cherry, clove and cola-scented spice cake. Soft, polished tannins uphold the piquant red fruits on the sip, where peppery spices, charred meats and wild herbs add nuance.	N/A	38	N/A
<b>Rickshaw</b> , California 2020 88 points - Wine Enthusiast. Quite fruity and not very tannic, this wine tastes fresh and easy, offering blackberries and blueberries and light oak spices. It is relatively light-bodied and will be great for casual occasions, even slightly chilled.	10		30
<b>Kerr Cellars</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2018 93 points - James Suckling. A succulent, juicy young red with plum, dark berry and some tile and bark undertones. It's full-bodied with layers of pure fruit and fine tannins. Lightly chewy at the end of the palate with a savory and fruity finish.	22		60
<b>My Favorite Neighbor</b> , San Luis Obispo County, CA 2020 95 points - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate. Deep ruby-purple, the 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon has pretty tones of green bell pepper, dried herbs, thyme, lavender and cedar over a core of red and black currant. The full-bodied palate is ultra juicy and packed with alluringly herbal fruit, and it boasts integrated oak, a soft, approachable frame and a long, perfumed finish.	N/A		75
<b>Burgess Contadina</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2017 95 points - Wine Enthusiast. This classically styled Napa Cabernet is big but balanced, offering savory black olive and bay leaf aromas that lead to potent, tasty black currant, mint and blueberry flavors. Silky, bracing tannins support the complex flavors, lending elegance and age-worthiness.	N/A		75
<b>Penfolds Bin 704</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2018 96 points - Wine Enthusiast. This is the first vintage of the Australian producer's foray into Napa Valley. It is tightly structured yet supple, bursting in bright currant and strawberry flavors. Savory components of sage, dried herb and black pepper dot the palate alongside silky tannins and chocolate-laced richness. A fresh touch of blood orange arises on the finish.	N/A		90

<b>7 Deadly 7 Deadly Zins</b> , Lodi, CA 2020 89 points - Wine Enthusiast. A Zin classic that never goes out of style. Rich, jammy black fruits are backed by the elevated (15%) alcohol and plushy tannic structure and complemented by oaky vanilla and nutmeg.	14	40
<b>Seghesio Angela's Table</b> , Sonoma, CA 2021 92 points - Wine Spectator. Plush in texture, this Zin is generous with blackberry and cherry flavors that draw in accents of briar patch, black pepper and toasty cinnamon as it finishes with zesty tannins.	18	48
