<b>Maschio - Prosecco</b> , Veneto, Italy D.O.C. N/V (187mL) 85 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This opens with aromas of honeysuckle and yellow stone fruit. On the palate, fresh acidity backs up ripe apricot and sweet white peach.	10	N/A
<b>Gérard Bertrand Heritage 'An 825' Brut</b> , Crémant de Limoux, Languedoc, France 2020 90 points <b>Wilfred Wong of Wine.com</b> . The 2019 Gérard Bertrand Héritage Crémant de Limoux Brut is pleasing and true-to-type. This wine deftly combines aromas and flavors of dried earth, sandalwood, and ripe fruit.		44
<b>Berlucchi '61 Rosé</b> , Franciacorta, Lombardy, Italy N/V 92 points – <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Bright and savory, this refreshing, polished sparkler boasts alluring aromas of juicy raspberry, wild cherry, baking spice and a whiff of bread crust. The inviting aromas follow over to the vibrant palate along with a continuous refined perlage. A tangy candied nectarine note closes the finish.		38
<b>Stella Rosa Imperiale Moscato D'Asti</b> , Piedmont, Italy N/V 91 Points <b>Gold Medal– Tastings</b> . This wine's uniqueness stems from its intense, concentrated aromas, flavors, natural sweetness, low alcohol, and natural carbonation. A tangy candied nectarine note closes the finish.		26
<b>Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut</b> , Champagne, France N/V 92 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . Aromas of grapefruit, citrus peel, quince, toast and almonds. It's medium-bodied with creamy, fine tannins. Silky texture. Nutty complexity at the end.		80

<b>Listel Grain de Gris</b> , IGP Terre du Midi, Languedoc, France 2021 <b>Winemaker's Notes</b> . Light pink color with hints of grey, leading to a bouquet of fresh red and citrus fruits. A supple, palate ensures long lasting balance and delicacy. A pleasant and refreshing wine.	8	24

#### Pinot Grigio/Gris\*

<b>Chloe</b> , Valdadige, Italy D.O.C. 2020 89 points - <b>Tastings</b> . Alluring aromatics lead into an intense expression of the Pinot Grigio grape with a generously structured mouthfeel. On the palate, fruit-forward flavors of juicy white peach, soft melon, crisp apple and floral honeysuckle lead to a crisp, refreshing finish with a subtle undertone of Meyer lemon.	11	30
<b>Ferrari-Carano</b> , Sonoma County, CA 2022 90 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . Aromas of candied lemons and white peaches with citrus blossom and dried herbs. Medium-bodied with lively acidity and crunchy, citrusy character. Chalky finish.	15	45
<b>Four Graces</b> , Willamette Valley, Oregon 2021 91 points – <b>Wine Enthusiast "Editor's Choice"</b> . Bright aromas of flower, whole melon, marzipan and hazelnuts lead to beautifully balanced fruit flavors that show depth and layering while remaining light on their feet. Tropical notes emerge on the lengthy finish.	17	48
<b>Kracher Trocken</b> , Burgenland, Austria 2020 92 points - <b>James Suckling</b> . Still quite leesy from long sur-lie maturation, but with a bit of air, bright lemon zest and sliced pear fruit, plus a whiff of vanilla open up. Excellent balance of substance and apple freshness, the textural complexity binding these things neatly together. Lovely freshness at the finish.	20	60

#### Chardonnay\*

	<u>Glass</u>	<u>Bottle</u>
<b>Rickshaw</b> , California, 2021 88 points – <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Well balanced and quaffable, this is a drink-me-now Chardonnay with notes of lemon, lime, yellow delicious apple, just-ripe yellow peach and nectarine, apricot, whipped meringue, chamomile flowers and a hint of toasted bread.	10	30
<b>Harken</b> , Central Coast, CA 2021 90 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . This full-bodied wine leads with bold new-oak aromas of grilled bread, wood char and butter, followed by luscious, ripe pear and vanilla flavors accented with toasted almonds. It's an unapologetic, barrel-fermented wine that gives a lot of pleasure.	12	36
<b>Chateau Ste Michelle Mimi</b> , Horse Heaven Hills, Columbia Valley, WA 2018 88 points - <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . The aromas are expressive, with notes of baking spice, crayon and peach. Medium-bodied supple flavors follow. Ripe peach notes linger on the finish.	12	36
<b>Chalk Hill</b> , Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA 2021 92 points – <b>Wine Spectator</b> . Presents pear drop, Fuji apple, ripe Bartlett pear and lemon blossom details that are elegant and restrained, but they weave in and out on a light, fresh frame that's quite impressive. Gains a savory element, thanks to a touch of toasted sesame seed.	17	46
<b>My Favorite Neighbor Blanc</b> , San Luis Obispo County, CA 2021 97 points – <b>Robert Parker's Wine Advocate</b> . Very ripe in style with scents of banana chip, apple pie, jasmine, allspice and brown sugar. The full-bodied palate is packed with ripe, spicy fruits and plenty of refreshing acidity, and it finishes long with a satiny, mouth-coating texture. It's an old-school style reminiscent of Napa that fans of ripe, oaked Chardonnays will enjoy.	N/A	85

<b>Rapaura Springs Classic</b> , Marlborough, New Zealand 2020 91 points – <b>Wine Spectator #41 Top 100 of 2021</b> . Vibrant and intense, showing notes of lemongrass and makrut lime leaf up front, with a juicy core of passion fruit and lime flavors. The intensity gains momentum on the long finish.	15	45
<b>Brendel Wines Everbloom</b> , Napa Valley, CA 2019 90 points – <b>Wine Spectator</b> . There's a wonderful effortlessness here, displaying vibrant citrus notes of lime, yuzu and grapefruit on a sleek and mouthwatering frame, with the intensity gaining momentum on the finish. 1,400 cases made.	14	40

#### Riesling\*

<b>Bex</b> , Nahe, Germany 2021 87 points – <b>Wine Enthusiast</b> . Ebullient pink grapefruit and tangerine notes extend from start to finish in this fruit-forward Riesling. It's delicately sweet yet refreshingly balanced in acidity. It is not a complex wine but a satisfying crowd-pleaser.	9	24
<b>Schloss Johannisberg Grünlack</b> , Rheingau, Germany 2020 99 points – <b>James Suckling</b> . Very cool and reserved at the front, but this is an enormously deep and complex wine that has staggering mineral intensity. The lime and oolong-tea freshness effortlessly swallows up the unfermented grape sweetness, as if it didn't really exist. The herbal freshness at the finish is really astounding.	N/A	70
